### Does your agency have a process for process measures?

Much like the issues surrounding medication management, therapy services will be challenged by the process measures being added to OASIS data collection on January 1, 2010. Defining scope of practice, roles and responsibilities, and communication strategies will be critical to facilitating a smooth transition to OASIS C. But how is this done? Even more importantly, what strategies should you implement now to ensure you are ready come January 1?

Never before has it been more important to develop a solid structure for care delivery. Not only can this positively impact your outcomes measurements and Home Health Compare score, it can also position your agency for success in 2010 and beyond.
