Why Do You Need Therapy Documentation Training?

The findings of recent audit activity have called into question the medical necessity of therapy visits. Being able to support “reasonable and necessary” is now a key part of answering M0826 correctly.

How real is this? The OIG audits of agencies in regions monitored by all four intermediaries found trends and problems of deep concern in every agency audited. The result: each of these agencies lost revenue due to improper documentation. Paybacks ranged from \$300,000 to over \$600,000.

Don't leave your agency vulnerable! This training will help you discover the components of appropriate therapy utilization. Knowing how to identify these core items in the documentation of each visit is key to determining a

therapist's “need” in the home. You can't afford to miss this training!
